oday, our enrolment is 287 students comprising 5 nationalities and 12 ethnic groups. CTC occupies 4 rented shoplots operating morning and afternoon sessions. Our staff of 15 teachers (13 refugees, 2 locals) and Administrator teach classes from kindergarten all the way to Grade 8.

Although CTC is a fee-paying school, our school fees are intentionally affordable to offer accessible education to as many



refugee children as possible. This year our Charity Dinner is on 5th October. The event will feature children's performances, stories of displacement and hope, ballet and more.
